ORDINANCE NO. 840.1.01
RE: DOG LICENSES


WHEREAS, by an act of the Kentucky General Assembly in 2004, responsibility for the sale and issuance of dog licenses has become the responsibility of local county governments, and

WHEREAS, the Trimble County Fiscal Court now finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Trimble County, Kentucky to enact this ordinance for the proper administration of the sale and issuance of dog licenses in Trimble County, Kentucky,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


- 1.) On or before July 1, 2004, and on or before January 1 of each year thereafter, the owner of any dog six (6) months old or over, which is kept in Trimble County, Kentucky, and outside the city limits of the two incorporated cities of Bedford and Milton, shall apply to the office of the County Judge/Executive of Trimble County for a license for each dog owned or kept by him.
- 2.) If a dog is less than six months old on January 1 of any calendar year, no dog license shall be required for that dog until January 1 of the following calendar year.
- 3.) For the period from July 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004 the fee for the dog license shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) for each license.
- 4.) For each calendar year beginning January 1, 2005, the fee for the dog license shall be Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each license and the license shall be effective from January 1 through December 31 of each calendar year.
- 5.) In the event that the municipal corporations of Bedford and/or Milton, decide to enter into an interlocal cooperation agreement to permit Trimble County to sell dog licenses for the municipalities, this ordinance shall apply to the citizens of either city that has entered into such interlocal cooperation agreement. Unless and until the cities enter into such interlocal cooperation agreements, the cities shall be responsible for the sale and issuance of the dog licenses for all dogs kept within the city limits of the respective cities.

After second reading on JUNE 30, 2003 the foregoing Ordinance was approved to be published and has been signed by the County Judge/Executive, Honorable Randy Stevens as evidence of his approval, attested under the seal of the Trimble County Fiscal Court Clerk.
