ORDINANCE NO. _____
AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO:
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS FOR THE
PURPOSE OF COSTS RELATED TO COURT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Kentucky State legislature enacted KRS 23A.220 in 2001 authorizing the collection of additional fees and court costs in Circuit Court cases for the purposes of paying expenses for courthouse, bonds related to them and administration expenses of Circuit Court; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky State legislature enacted KRS 24A.185 in 2001 authorizing the collection of additional fees and court costs in District Court cases for the purposes of paying expenses for courthouse, bonds related to them and administration expenses of District Court,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF TRIMBLE COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, pursuant to KRS 23A.220 and KRS 24A.185:

In Circuit Court civil cases, pursuant to KRS 23A.220 (1), a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be added to filing fees;

In Circuit Court criminal cases, pursuant to KRS 23A.220 (2), a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be added to the court costs that the defendant is required to pay;

In civil cases that are appealed from the Circuit Court to the Court of Appeals, pursuant to KRS 23A.220(3), a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be added to filing fees;

In District Court traffic cases, pursuant to KRS 24A.185 (1), a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to court costs;

In District Court probate cases, pursuant to KRS 24A.185 (2), a filing fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to each filing fee;

In District Court misdemeanor cases, pursuant to KRS 24A.185 (3), a fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00) shall be added to court costs;


In District Court small claims cases, pursuant to KRS 24A.185 (4), a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to all filing fees;

In District Court civil cases, pursuant to KRS 24A.185 (5), a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be added to all filing fees;

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 26th day of January, 2011. Hereafter the Clerk of the Trimble Circuit Court and the Trimble County Sheriff's shall no later than monthly remit to the Trimble County Treasurer all the increased fees set forth herein. Said fees shall be expended by the Trimble County Fiscal Court through the Trimble County Judge/Executive for the purposes set forth in KRS 23A.220 and KRS 24A.185.

Until such time as this ordinance takes effect, the Clerk of the Trimble Circuit Court and the Trimble County Sheriff shall continue to collect all fees authorized by the Trimble County Ordinance, Number 220.23 enacted November 20, 2000 and shall remit all fees collected thereunder to the Trimble County Treasurer.


